Beauty therapists perform many treatments including facials, massages, waxing, lash, and brow treatments. Beauty therapists also offer nail treatments, makeup and spa treatments. They are trained to recommend aftercare products to their clients to achieve optimal results. Beauty therapists always have an eye on up-and-coming beauty trends to offer the latest and advanced treatments to their clients.

## Mode of Assessment

The delivery of the course will be blended learning.

The theory will be delivered online. You will have a designated lecturer assigned to assist you.

The practical components will be delivered on campus.

The on-campus training will be on Tuesdays from 9-2.

Additional practical hours are to be completed in the student clinic. The units include waxing (38 hours), lash and brow (8 hours) , make-up (8 hours), nail filing (8 hours) manicure and pedicate (10 hours) and spray tanning (3 hours) , Please contact your lecturer to find a regular time for you to come in for your clinic hours.

The hours are dependant on the clinic opening hours.

The hours can only be completed once you have passed the theory components and practical assesments.
