What is Beauty Therapy?

This course will set you up for a career in beauty therapy. Beauty therapists enhance their client's appearance, promote wellbeing and offer a range of personal care and health services. Beauty therapists perform many treatments including facials, massages, waxing, lash, and brow treatments. Beauty therapists also offer nail treatments, makeup and spa treatments. They are trained to recommend aftercare products to their clients to achieve optimal results. Beauty therapists always have an eye on up-and-coming beauty trends to offer the latest and advanced treatments to their clients.

Duration

12 Months full time. The amont of training equate to roughly 1625 hours. The on campus components will consit of Tuesday's 9-2. There will be no class during school holidays. The hours on campus and include pracitcal demonstrations, asessments and some theory. Students are required to complete an additional 114 hours of log book hours on campus. Students are required to complete around 23 hours of structured learning at home per week. This will include textbook reading, watching lectures, conducting research and practising beauty skills.

Mode of Assessment

The delivery of the course will be blended learning. The theory will be delivered online. You will have a designated lecturer assigned to assist you.

The practical components will be delivered on campus. The on-campus training will be on Tuesdays 9-2. Additional practical hours are to be completed in the student clinic. The units include waxing (38 hours), facials (38 hours) and massage (38 hours). Please contact your lecturer to find a regular time for you to come in for your clinic hours. The hours are dependent on the clinic opening hours.
