



## What is Lymphatic Drainage Massage?

This massage style is focused on improving lymphatic flow. Lymphatic drainage massage is a very gentle and light technique that helps to improve lymphatic flow and aid toxin removal. This style of massage is excellent for client's who is wanting to detoxify, have pain, swelling or low immunity. This style of massage can also be performed post-operatively under medical supervision. It is also excellent before a special occasion or after a holiday. Lymphatic drainage massage has a very specific sequence and specialised techniques to help move lymph.
